

Over the last few decades, the idea of **infusing entrepreneurship into education** has spurred great enthusiasm in light of the myriad of positive effects stated to result from it: from economic growth and job creation all the way to individual growth, increased school engagement and improved equality.

European policies have shown equal interest in entrepreneurship and produced recently a competence framework (EntreComp) to build consensus around a common understanding of the topic.

In light of this and of the EQAVET framework, the project seeks to **improve quality assurance in entrepreneurship** educa**tion** and **enhance the training offers for VET providers** in this sector.

To this end, the project seeks to develop the following **results**:



A **baseline report** to highlight difficulties and successes in implementing quality assurance in entrepreneurship education so far, as well as collect relevant data.

A common reference framework developed to help future Quality Managers in entrepreneurship education to understand, plan and implement the quality assurance strategy in their organisation.

Guidelines aiming at providing the right adaptation of the EQAVET standards and tools to entrepreneurship education.

A description of the Quality Manager's main competences and required skills, as well as training contents.

Recommendations for the **implementation** of the whole system.

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
